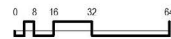

NEEDS INCLUDE:

Equipment & Program Needs: \$1,400,000

To purchase, update, and maintain state-of-the-art equipment and anticipate future educational needs. This investment will expand Schoolcraft's health sciences programs and serve more students to meet the increased demand for healthcare careers.

Outreach, Internship & Apprenticeship Program: \$600,000 over four years

Schoolcraft is committed to giving healthcare occupational/technical students a personalized, Reality Ready™ experience. Located at the corner

of 7 Mile and Haggerty, Schoolcraft's Livonia campus is literally in the heart of a "health care triangle." The College has a unique opportunity to partner with industry leaders. Students will have an opportunity for hands-on experiences at St. Joseph Mercy Healthcare, which has facilities located right on the College campus. Beaumont, Henry Ford Health System, and U of M Health Care are located within a mile of the campus. Schoolcraft is committed to helping students learn with hands-on experiences to sustainable careers. Funding would support outreach to businesses and coordinate internship opportunities.

HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER EXPANSION

Construction began fall 2020 with projected completion in winter 2022. The Center will expand current health sciences programs and create an environment that helps students demonstrate critical thinking abilities while solving clinical problems, advancing communication skills, and building clinical competencies.

The expansion will include a 30,000 sq. foot addition to house Nursing and Pharmacy Technician programs. This building will centralize the EMT/Paramedic, Medical Assistant, and Health Information Technology programs.

New laboratories also will be designed to support new health professions, including Radiologic Technology, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Surgical Technology, and Sterile Processing programs. Local healthcare providers also will use simulation labs for training.
